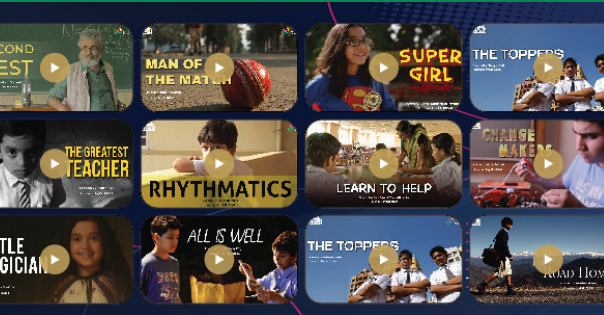
Our school has partnered with Edusports Sportzvilleage.
